
Print out pages 1 and 2 (try using card stock paper for extra sturdy results). Cut out R2-D2 mailbox model along its cut lines, and fold all mountain and valley fold lines before assembling.

Instructions:

1. Glue tab A behind back panel.
2. Glue tab B behind back panel.
3. Glue tab C behind right panel.
4. Glue tab D behind left panel.
5. Glue tabs E and F to left and right panels at a 90-degree angle.



6. Apply glue behind tab G, and glue to the back of its own panel.
7. Apply glue behind tab H, and glue to the back of left panel.




8. Try adding a staple as the mailbox handle!
